- Facilitate Community Walks along each bike lane.

2:30pm to 3:30pm, leaving from Northumberland Rd, (1) on map.

Before the Community Walks we will:


- Ask local volunteers (of different backgrounds, ages, interests etc.) to sign up to guide a small part (e.g. 10 minutes) of 1-2 walks.
- Support the Community Walk guides with a short pre-walk briefing and support them on the walk/s.

At the Community Walks we will:

- Be led by the consultant and volunteer community members
- Have a Council Officer present to take photos and notes, and answer questions.

During and after the engagement activities

We will continue to interpret the information that we receive.

In response to community feedback, we are now proposing a shorter 12-month trial period to evaluate community feedback and traffic survey data.

Final report

A report will be presented to Council in July 2022, which will include:

- Summary of engagement activities
- Analysis of findings
- Recommendations on the future of the project

Depending on the recommendations and outcomes of the trial, the Council may decide to make these separated bicycle lanes permanent, make further adjustments to the design, extend the trial period or abandon the project.
